Source : Fleur de Lys Morris, Godalming, derived ultimately from Martha Rhoden's "Last Night with Archie" but danced with sticks etc.

Music : "Not for Joe".

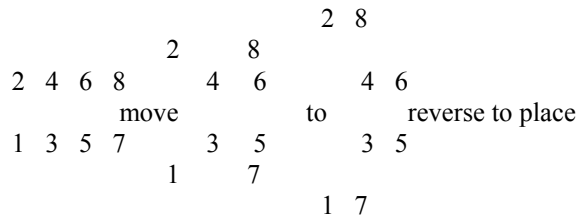
Sticks : each dancer has two short sticks.

Set : 8 dancers in two lines that change direction during the dance.

CHORUS : the dance starts and ends with a chorus. The last time is repeated at double speed. In between are the figures.

Sticking : /b r+r b r+r /b l+l b l+l /b r.diag b r.diag /b l.diag b r.diag /
/b r+r b r+r /b l+l b l+l /r.diag - l diag - /b l+l r+r - //

FIGURES : Cast Back = end twos of each line of four along the set, cast outwards through the ends, turning three quarters to face up-&-down the set in lines of four across the set. The ends are still ends and the middles are middles. Return to place is the inverse.



1. Cast back, back-to-back both ways with the new opposite and cast back.
2. Cast back, half gyp (Federation Ilmington style) each side and cast back.
3. Cast back, half rounds each way in fours, cast back.
