

## A "PERSHORE"

**Source** : Iron Men at Sidmouth.  
**Music** :  
**Steps** : hopsteps.  
**Sticks** : short stick each.  
**Set** : 8 dancers, initially in a circle, but mostly in two lines of 4.

This so called Pershore dance is a variant of the common "Wenlock" family.

OTYS : stand in circle with sticks in the centre making a star (basket).

1. **ROUNDS** : whole rounds with sticks on shoulders, facing across in bar 8.
2. **STICKS** : odds strike evens who hold their sticks still in Brimfield/Wenlock fashion.  
 / f b f b f / f b f b / b - f - / b f b - //  
 then evens hit odds in the same rhythm.
3. **HEY** : Worcester heys for four, tops go between top middles, bottom two pairs turn out at the bottom, bottom middles following the bottoms.
4. **STICKS**
5. **CROSS OVER** : partners pass left shoulders and turn to the right to face  
 back, waist swing with opposite three times round to end in starting place.

9. **STARS** : first half hands across in fours, turn out at half way, into middle star back and end pairs waist swing.

17. **ROUNDS** : whole rounds clockwise, turning out at the end and hitting down onto the fool who has moved into the centre of the set.
