#### 2 Constitution Review

### MOTION 1 - To accept revised Constitutional Documents

The new Constitution documents had been circulated for comments and the proposed documents circulated in the pack for voting in advance.

It was confirmed that Motion 1 had received 391 votes For; 7.5 votes Against; 131.3 Abstentions.

Thanks for getting us this far were extended to Jerry West (Notation Officer) who has been heading up the review, and our consultation group: Pam Morley (Aelfgythe), Duncan Moss (Hammersmith Morris), and Fee Lock (JMO Secretary) with written input from John New (Cockleshell Clog) and Bob Barker (Ripon Spur Rapper). They received a round of applause.

Jerry West (heading up the review) gave some background to the alterations made saying that the constitution group had kept as far as practicable within the spirit of the original constitution. During this review, he noted the polarized approaches to writing a constitution and fed this back to the group. He explained that they had tried to be formal but accessible and use language for clarity rather than precise but obscure.

Just prior to this EGM meeting, 33 amendments had been tabled.

Via screen share to all present, each of the amendments was taken in turn and wording discussed. The document was updated at the meeting, the document with the amendments shown in Mark Up had been shared in advance. This process continued up to point 7.4 (Definition of Postal Ballot) when the meeting closed being out of time.

Items prior to 7.4 that remain unresolved are:

- Voting and Show of Hands
- Resolutions to take immediate effect or at closure of the meeting?
- Officers it was agreed 6 elected officers to include those named, President, Treasurer, Secretary but no agreement was reached on what the other 3 would be called or who writes the job descriptions.
- Accounts at AGM title and remit of the verifier of the accounts and to what level of checking is undertaken.

Before closure, discussion took place as to how completing this process should occur. It was agreed that the following would be the next steps for action:

- 1. Jerry West to make updates to the documents based on the EGM discussions.
- A meeting to be held to discuss 'Voting' (and anything else outstanding) we will send an invite to attend
  to all those who attended the EGM, to act as an advisory group. [Post-meeting note: this was held on 13<sup>th</sup>
  December 2023]
- 3. Revised version to be circulated to all of the EGM participants for review.
- 4. Jerry West to review comments and create a final version.
- 5. Final version to be circulated to the whole Membership to vote on, with a summary of what has changed.

#### 3 Discussions

#### DISCUSSION 1 - Honorary Life Membership

This item was not considered, but the new mechanism agreed at the 2022 AGM is absent from the new constitution; the pre-existing method of awarding Honorary Life Membership is in Standing Orders.

**Post-Meeting Note:** In future, the Committee will ensure that Nominations for awarding Honorary Life Membership and Friendship of the MF will become an Agenda item on AGMs. Requests for nominations will be included along with requests for nominations of Elections of Officers, Motions and Discussion items.
