

Dance Spots.

1. Riverside Arena.

A large, flat circular area between the Riverside Ice Cream Parlour (opens at 10 am) and the children's playground, next to the Riverside car parks (£3.50 all day parking).



2. Riverside Park



A flat, circular dance spot in front of the Obelisk with Newark Castle across the river as a backdrop.

3. Town Lock

Opposite the lock on the River Trent. There is room for the musicians in front of a set of locked gates. Dancers could stand behind the bollards when they are not dancing to facilitate pedestrian movement.



4. Newark Castle – the Bandstand

An obvious place to dance!



5. Newark Castle - next to the

3D model of the Castle.

This is a relatively small dance space.

Do your best!



6. The Wharf



Dancing between the Castle Barge, Newark's famous floating pub, and the Trent Bridge. This area has been flooded several times during the winter so take care as the surface is not as flat as it used to be – but it

has been washed by the river! If you think it is not safe to dance there, the nearby pavement at the National Express coach stop ([w3w: thrashed.easy.decimals](http://w3w:thrashed.easy.decimals)) could be used.



7. The Old Post Office beer garden. The pub will have cleared an area for dancing.



8. Market Place – in front of the Town Hall

A large performance area.



9. Market Place – at the top of Bridge Street near HSBC.
